

#### "The Hysterical Woman"

- Exploring the pain and fear present in this script
- Using a 60's aesthetic
  - Taking a moment of peak beauty only for it to decay



### Concept cont.

- 98% of the play you only see the woman's lips as she speaks
  - Use props around the lips to tell the story of her anxiety and mental state through the show
    - Drinking
    - Biting nails
    - Smoking
    - Taking pills
    - Smearing lipstick
- When it is revealed in the text she has the cord around her throat, the light will expand to she her full disheveled self. Messy hair, mascara running down cheeks, and the cord around her throat.

Because the story waits until the end to reveal this fact, I want to also leave my audience in suspense until the final moment.



At first glance everything seems normal, a woman on the phone late at night.



Then we see her nerves grow through small hints, such as smoking.



Or, drinking.



Though we cannot see her, mouth acting keeps us up to date on her feelings during this phone call.



These props and nervous tics solidify the audience's sympathy and mental state of our character.



Until we see her start to destroy herself, or what she hoped this phone call would be.
